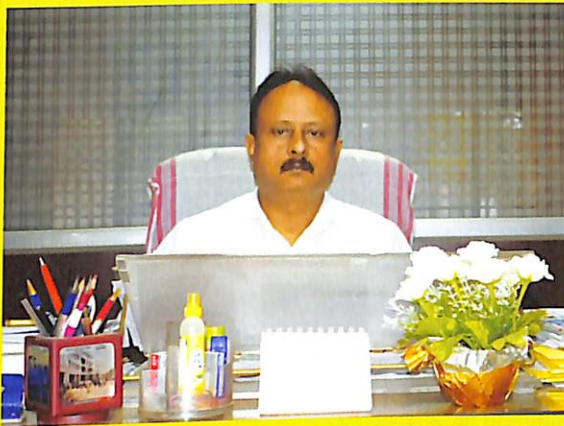

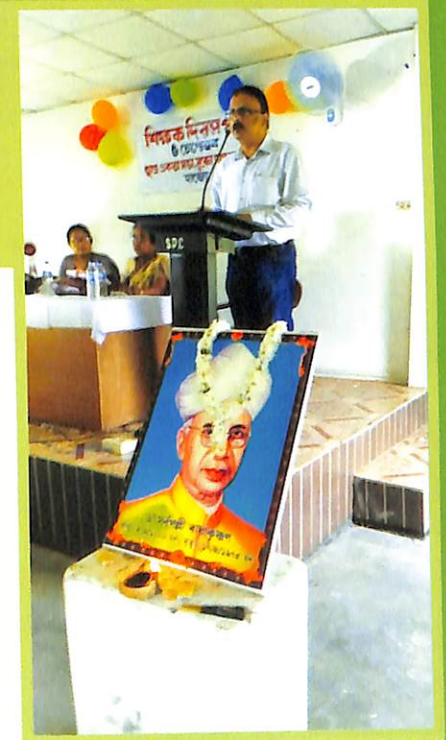


#### Teachers' Day
