
SEMINARS AND LECTURE PROGRAMMES

On 27th May, 2022, the Department of Education arranged one day workshop on preparation of Lesson-Plan to develop teaching ability among the students.




Workshop on 'Find the confident You'



Soil analysis based on complexometric titration

A soil analysis based on complexometric titration was performed from 17th February to 22nd February, 2022 by the Department of Chemistry in order to estimate the amount of macro nutrients such as Calcium and Magnesium in soil samples of Suren Das College, Hajo. A group of 30 students from the 3rd semester participated in this drive and the results for the analysis has been presented as a report by the individual students.




